- Attached is the Division Memorandum dated January 7, 2025, titled *Training-Seminar on Officiating in Various Sports Disciplines for the 2025 Negros Occidental Provincial Athletic Association Meet*. This three-day, live-out training seminar on officiating in various sports disciplines will be held from January 16-18, 2025, at designated venues.
- This office has identified participants who will serve as technical officials for the upcoming 2025 Provincial Meet and has recommended potential participants for sports disciplines with fewer expected entries.
- To avoid disrupting the classes of the teachers involved in this activity, identified participants will arrange their class schedules in advance, switch to the distance learning modality, and provide modules as needed.
- School heads are advised to prepare alternative modes of learning delivery** for the schedules of identified participants for their duty.
- Travel, meals, accommodation, and other incidental expenses incurred during participation in this training may be charged against the School MOOE, subject to the availability of funds and in accordance with the usual budgeting, accounting, auditing, and procurement rules.
- Participation and services rendered by nationally paid teaching, teaching related personnel to the conduct of this activity which are held outside of the regular school days are entitled to service credits. On the other hand, the non-teaching is entitled of the Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) as provided in DepEd Order No. 53 s. 2003.
- It is understood that DepEd Sagay City Division commits to integrate the principles of gender equality, equity and sensitivity, non-discrimination, and human rights, in the provision of governance of basic education. This is in line with the DepEd's mandate to ensure access to quality basic education and equal opportunities for all.

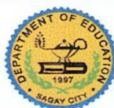



Date: **January 7, 2025**

1. In preparation for the upcoming 2025 Negros Occidental Provincial Athletic Association Meet, the Department of Education - Province of Negros Occidental, through the Negros Occidental Provincial Athletic Association, will conduct a three-day Live-Out Training-Seminar on Officiating in various sports disciplines on January 16–18, 2025, at designated venues.
2. This Training-Seminar aims to:
 - a. update officiating officials and coaches on the latest guidelines, rules, and regulations in their respective sports disciplines;
 - b. familiarize participants with their roles, duties, and responsibilities as technical officials and coaches for the successful conduct of the meet; and
 - c. enhance their competencies with the current trends and strategies in officiating/coaching.
3. Expected Participants of this activity are the identified technical officials who will serve in the upcoming 2025 Provincial Meet and coaches/assistant coaches from various Schools Division Offices (SDO) participating in the 2025 Provincial Meet. In addition, each SDO and district of SDO Negros Occidental may recommend potential participants for sports disciplines with fewer expected participants. These disciplines include: Archery; Arnis; Baseball; Billiards; Boxing; Futsal; Gymnastics (MAG/WAG, RG, Aero); Softball; Taekwondo; Wrestling; Wushu; Pencak Silat; Pickleball; and Paragames.

5. The activity will be facilitated by tournament directors and expert technical officials/coaches with national and international experienced. Schools Division Superintendents, PSDSs, and school heads of the identified resource persons, facilitators, and participants are requested to allow them to serve/attend this activity.
6. Attached is the List of Training Venues and Resource Persons/Facilitators for the respective sports disciplines. School heads of training venues are requested to provide session halls/rooms and billeting classrooms for participants who choose to stay on-site during the training period.
7. All participants must be medically and physically fit. A medical certificate issued by a government physician must be presented during registration. Pregnant women are advised not to attend.
8. Participants must report to their respective training venues no later than 8:00 AM on January 16, 2025 for registration and the Opening Program.
9. No registration fee will be collected. Participants will be responsible for their food and accommodation. Those opting to stay on-site must coordinate with their respective resource persons, who will inform and coordinate with the host schools/divisions.
10. The conduct of this activity will uphold the principle of equal opportunity, with no discrimination based on age, gender, civil status, disability, religion, ethnicity, political affiliation, or similar factors.
11. Travel and other related expenses for participants, resource persons, and facilitators will be charged to local/MOOE funds or other available sources, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
