 - Storybook Writing Competition in three (3) categories
- All members of the committees and School heads of participating schools are requested to attend and facilitate attendance of their coaches, and selected students to show support to their contestants.
- Attached are the revised guidelines and mechanics of the Readers Theater Competition as agreed last November 9, 2024, during the Training-Workshop as enclosure No. 1, to this Memorandum.
- Participants who will be rendering services on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays in preparation for the Culmination are entitled to 1.5 days official service credits per DepED Order # 53, s. 2003.
- Travel Expenses of the participants relative to the attendance of the stated activities shall be charged against School MOOE or from other school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.

REVISED GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS OF READER'S THEATRE COMPETITION

1. Each Team shall be composed of 15 participants.
2. Lapel is optional
3. Background music and sound effects are not allowed
4. Participants must be enrolled in any Secondary Schools in this division
5. Participants is given eight (8) minutes including entrance and exits

Criteria for Judging are as follows:

- **Voice Mechanics (30%)**
(speaks with an appropriate volume for the audience to hear)
- **Face/Body/Gesture (10%)**
(Expressively uses non-verbal communication to clarify the meaning of the text)
- **Focus (10%)**
(Concentration is clear. Eye contact with the audience is engaging)
- **Characterization (25%)**
(Characters are believable to listeners. Readers natural voice is differentiated from character voices.)
- **Use of Speech (15%)**
(Reader seems comfortable, relaxed and confident in front of Listeners)
- **Pacing (10%)**
(the play is presented efficiently and keeps listeners' interest throughout)
