SUBJECT : REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE FOR AFFECTED POPULATION
 OF MT. KANLAON ERUPTION



On 03 June 2024 at around 6:51 PM, an explosive eruption occurred at the summit vent of Kanlaon Volcano which produced a voluminous and incandescent plume that rapidly rose to 5,000 meters above the vent and probable short pyroclastic density currents or PDCs approximately 2 to 3 kilometers down the southern and southeastern slopes. The eruption resulted in massive evacuation of residents who were affected by the ashfall and the subsequent lahar flows.

The city of La Carlota and the municipality of La Castellana were two of the most affected LGUs. Based on the Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis report submitted by the two LGUs, the following are the priority needs:

Area	Priority Needs
Health	Medicines, PPEs
Food and Nutrition	Drinking water, Food packs, noodles, canned goods
WASH	Wash Kits, Water kits, water filtration kits and filter machine
Shelter and NFIs	Modular Tents, Kitchenware, sleeping kits, modular tents
Protection	PPEs, boots, full cover face masks, KN95 masks
Others	Water filtration, Generator, rain boots
