

3. The competition launches six (6) new categories found in the enclosure NO.1 of this memorandum.
4. Each district is advised to submit six (6) potential writers address to the office of the Schools Division Superintendent not later than July 10, 2024.
5. Division orientation for this activity will be on July 12, from 1:00 to 5:00 pm at Eusebio Lopez Memorial Integrated School.
6. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination of the participants on account of age, school, gender civil status, disability, religion, or other similar factors, or personal circumstances that run counter to the principles of equal opportunity.
