- The SDO Sagay City through the Curriculum and Implementation Division (CID) will conduct a 2-day Training-Workshop to Coaches and selected secondary learners on October 22 & 23 at Sagay National High School in preparation for the forthcoming DROIDS Fair in November. Date and Venue of the culmination will be announced later.
- This activity aims to achieve the following objectives:
 - Develop a research-based mobile application; and
 - Effectively pitched the participants' product to stimulate an industry-based needs.
- The school may send two (2) or three (3) learner-participants to this training and one (1) coach-representative. Participants to this training are encouraged to initiate coaching sessions through LAC if the school wishes to have two to five (5) teams. However, coaches who had undergone similar training may opt not to attend the training and may submit the team's output on the set deadline instead. The top 15 teams will be selected and will compete on the DROIDS Fair Culmination which will be happening in November.
- Activity Matrix and Learning Facilitators to this activity are found in the enclosure of this memorandum.
- Expenses incurred during the activity will be charged to school MOOE and other school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- In the absence of teachers due to attendance in this activity, Blended Learning Modality shall be adopted. Utilization of Self-Learning Modules (SLMs) is advised for the affected classes. Attendance of learners in other classes shall continue. Intervention/Reinforcement activities shall be given to learners who will participate in this activity.
- It is understood that in the conduct of this activity there shall be no discrimination in the provision of such partnership on account of age, school, gender, civil status, disability, religion or other similar factors, personal circumstances that run counter to the principles of equal opportunity.
- Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.


