DISTRIBUTION OF BRIGHT SMILES, BRIGHT FUTURES (BSBF) KITS TO KINDERGARTEN PUPILS IN PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2024- 2025

1. The Dental Health Unit of SDO Sagay City, in partnership with Colgate-Palmolive Philippines, Inc. (CPPI), will distribute oral health bundles to kindergarten pupils in public elementary schools. This initiative is part of the Bright Smiles, Bright Futures Program (BSBF), which provides oral care kits, educational materials, and dental services to public school children.
2. This activity aims to educate learners about the importance of oral health, as well as the effectiveness of overall daily hygiene and its role in maintaining overall bodily health.
2. Each identified school will receive a BSBF box/package that includes the following: A Classroom Kit containing toothbrushes and Maximum Cavity Protection Toothpaste (214g), with quantities varying based on the number of learners per classroom.
3. The **distribution activity will run from October 22 to 30, 2024**. The pick-up of packages will take place at the **SDO School Health Section, Clinic Area**. To avoid crowding, please follow the schedule below:
