

INVITATION TO THE WORLD SCIENCE CHAMPIONSHIP

1. The Schools Division Office through the Curriculum and Implementation Division (CID) invites the elementary and secondary schools to participate in the World Science Championship.
2. This international competition offers a significant opportunity for students to engage with scientific concepts in a meaningful manner, thereby enhancing their confidence and problem-solving abilities. Structured to be inclusive, the competition accommodates students of varying abilities from Kindergarten through grade 8. Its primary objective is to foster love for science through a comprehensive and enriching educational experience.
3. The competition will consist of objective-type questions that are directly aligned with the students' current curriculum, thereby eliminating the necessity for supplementary study materials. The exam for Grades 1–4 will have 35 questions, and the exam for Grades 5–8 will have 50 questions. The examination modality is online, and per-paper based exam. A mock test will be available from November 1 to November 21, 2024 to help students familiarize themselves with the exam format.
4. Learners from Kindergarten to Grade 8 are eligible to participate in the competition. An examination fee of USD 15 per student will be charged and the last date of registration will be on November 18, 2024. **The exam dates are set for November 22, 2024, and November 30, 2024.**
5. Schools are encouraged to assist with the registration of interested participants. Parents can also register their children individually if they prefer.
