**SCHOOL-BASED FILIPINO VALUES MONTH CELEBRATION 2024**

1. This Schools Division Office joins in the celebration of **Filipino Values Month** from November 1-30, 2023 with the Theme, "**Pagsusulong ng Bagong Pilipinas: Ang Kabataan Bilang Pundasyon ng Pagbabago**". It is along with this premise that public elementary and secondary schools of this division are encouraged to hold a school-based celebration any day in November, 2023. The celebration may highlight celebration in the forms of literary pieces such as essay, verses, poem, songs, role plays, and others which are textual, audio or video formats.
2. The enumerated presentations are expected to: give credence to the fore stated theme, magnify the Division Innovation- V-BC (Values-Based Culture), and contribute much for the attainment of MELCs (*Most Essential Learning Competencies*) in EsP (*Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao*) /GMRC (*Good Manners & Right Conduct*) through Lesson Integration that has to be reflected on teacher's Daily Lesson Log or Daily Lesson Plan. This celebration may also foster love of God and love of Country through learners' performance tasks.
3. Each District through EsP District Coordinator will consolidate the celebration activities of schools, and will be able to report the same on **December 6, 2024 via online or offline**.
4. Public schools District Supervisors and school heads are encouraged to supervise EsP Coordinators and teachers for the attainment of this celebration.
5. Connectivity and other expenses incurred by schools and or participants during the conduct of School-Based Filipino Values Month 2024 are chargeable against school funds subject to the usual COA rules and regulations.
6. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity there shall be no discrimination in the provision of such assessment on account of age, school, gender, civil status, health status, disability, religion or other similar factors/personal circumstances that run counter to the principles of equal opportunity. Health and safety protocols shall also be given due course of consideration.
