DIVISION MEMORANDUMNo. 712, s. 2024**SCHOOL-BASED AND DISTRICT- BASED GIRL SCOUT ENCAMPMENT**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

1. Adherence to the requirement to the GSP Provincial Council Circular No. 11 on the conduct of the **Provincial GSP Encampment**, which is set to take place from November 25-29, 2024, in Victorias City, this office allows all schools and District field offices to conduct a **2-Day School-Based and or District-Based Synchronized GSP encampment on November 4-5, 2024** at venues designated by respective school or district.

2. The following schedule of the conduct of the encampment must be strictly followed:

Date & Time	Activity
November 4, 2024 3:00PM – Onwards	Settling Down Opening Program GSP Camp Activities
November 5, 2024 5:00AM – onwards	Continuation of the GSP Camp Activities Closing Program

3. All PSDSs, Designated District Federation Advisers (DFAs), and School Heads are strongly encouraged to take the initiative and effectively manage the execution of the activity and in identifying the participants for the Provincial Encampment.

4. Likewise, DFAs are kindly requested to submit the list of TLs and girl participants by November 6, 2024. This can be done either by sending the list to the Division Records Office or via messenger to Josette P. Balandra.

5. Requirement on the conduct of this activity are the following:
 a. troop leaders and Girl Scouts must be currently registered.
 b. Girl Scouts without this permission will not be allowed to participate.
 c. participation in this activity is strictly voluntary.

6. Meals, travel, incidental, and other expenses of the participants of this activity are chargeable to the Canteen Funds, PTA, and other local funds while management and logistics of the conduct of this activity maybe charged against School MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

7. Participation and services rendered by nationally paid teaching personnel outside of regular school days (DO 53, s. 2003) are entitled to service credits. Teaching-related and non-teaching personnel are eligible for Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) for hours worked beyond regular hours, including Saturdays, Sundays, holidays, or scheduled days off (DO 53, s. 2003).

8. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity there shall be no discrimination in the provision of such partnership on account of age, school, gender, civil status, disability, religion or other similar factors, personal circumstances that run counter to the principles of equal opportunity.

9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

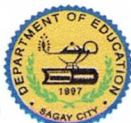

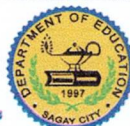
