

Subject : **7th BSP-NOC Invitational Scout Jamborette, 3rd Council Rover Moot**

1. Lord Baden-Powell has given importance to the progressive outdoor-based non-formal education, wherein through that direction, scouting became attractive in the eyes of the community. Woodlore and wildfire are the factors why scouting is still alive today. Its outdoor character gives credence and influence to the inner core of society making it the centerpiece of the scouting program, which continues to attract the hearts of the young to join the scouting movement. The need to give importance to our cultural heritage and the environment through learning the values of outdoor life is an urgent agenda of scouting to develop the character of the youth.

We are pleased to announce that the Boy Scouts of the Philippines - Negros Occidental Local Council Executive Board during its meeting dated August 6, 2024, approved the holding of the 7th BSP-NOC Invitational Scout Jamboree, 3rd Council Rover Moot upon cordial acceptance of **HONORABLE MAYOR JOEDITH C. GALLEGO** of Silay City to host this memorable provincial wide event.

DATE : **December 25-30, 2024**
VENUE : **Brgy. Eustaquio Lopez, Silay City, Negros Occidental**

2. **Aims and Objectives.** The 7th BSP-NOC Invitational Scout Jamborette, 3rd Council Rover Moot aims:
 - 2.1. To develop scouts to have a holistic awareness of the natural world and how their day-to-day actions can impact upon this, progressively building a sense of responsibility for the environment.
 - 2.2. To achieve Peace and Unity among all young boys in Negros Occidental including boys from other Provinces as a number one thrust to attain stability.
 - 2.3. To experience and connect with nature using all the senses and understand how the Information from our senses combines to create an awareness of the natural world by implementing the World Scout Environment Programme, including its component programs SCENES Initiatives and Scouts Go Solar, at national and local/community level;
 - 2.4. To contribute to the Education of young people, through a value system based on the Scout Promise and Law.
 - 2.5. To duly build a better world where people are self-fulfilled as individuals and play a constructive role in society.
 - 2.6. To raise awareness of how we contribute to climate change in our daily lives by understanding how our everyday actions are associated with releasing greenhouse gases into the atmosphere;

- 2.7. To explore the local ecosystem from the point of view of the animals and plants that live there, and provide opportunities to learn about the natural features of the center and surrounding natural environment.
- 2.8. To learn the importance of Community Service and Development which will strengthen the Spirit of togetherness the Scouting way.
- 2.9 To instill Scout discipline.

3. **Qualifications.** For an individual to qualify to participate in the 7th BSP-NOC Invitational Scout Jamborette, 3rd Council Rover Moot the following standards must be met:

3.1. **Scout** is expected to have leadership potential, physically fit to undergo strenuous activities and parent's approval, and must be:

- Currently registered as Boy/Senior Scouts / Rover Scouts
- At least 9 to 12 years old for Boy Scouts 13 years old but not over 17 years old for Senior Scouts / Rover Scouts 16 years old and above.
- Equipped with camping gears
- Duly examined by a Registered Physician certifying good health condition to attend this event.

3.1. **Adult Leaders** must have maturity and clarity about their role and must be:

- Currently registered Unit Leader
- Trained as Troop Leader/Outfit Advisor and undergone at least BTC for Unit Leaders and of Good Moral character.
- Duly examined by a Registered Physician certifying that he/she is physically fit to act and administer his/her unit in camp.
- Equipped with camping gears

4. **Registration Details:** Stated below are important information of Jamborette Registration, to wit;

4.1. **Registration Fee.** A Registration Fee of **Six Hundred Pesos (Php 600.00)** shall be charged to each participant to defray expenses for the program materials, administrative costs, souvenir items, and other operating expenses. The **registration fee, food, transportation, and other incidental expenses** are chargeable to local funds / local school board Special Education Funds/MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations set by Law.

4.1.1. **Pre-Registration Fee.** A Pre-Registration Fee of **Three Hundred Pesos (Php 300.00)** shall be remitted to the Local Council Depository Bank;

- Participants must complete and submit the Roster of Participants with corresponding Deposit Slip. This will determine the number of participants in the procurement of the souvenir items.

- The deadline for the **Pre-Registration of Jamborette Registration Fee** will be on or before **15 November 2024**.

4.1.2. **Full Payment.** The deadline for the **Full Payment of Jamborette Registration Fee** will be on or before **15 December 2024**.

5. **Transportation and Equipment:** The contingent will be responsible for arranging their own transportation to and from the campsite. Like in any other camping, Scouts and Adult Leaders are required to provide their own camping equipment and gadgets.

6. **On Official Business.**

a. The Boy Scouts, Senior Scouts, and Rover Scouts including Department of Education personnel involved, volunteers, and active in Scouting are authorized to attend and participate in this Provincial Scouting Event.




