

Greetings!

The Young Adult Fertility and Sexuality Study or the YAFS V shows the prevalence of teenage pregnancy among Filipino youth declined by 50%, from 13.7% in 2013 to 6.8% in 2021. At the same time, there was a decline in the percentage of youth who engaged in premarital and early sex. In terms of mental health, 17% have ever thought of committing suicide, a third of whom experienced suicide ideation more than once. These results were gathered from various adolescent groups including in – school and out –of-school youths, and LGBTQ++ member. Locally, in the year 2024, according to the Sagay City Health Office, there were 243 recorded teen pregnancy (10 - 19 years old). In order to continuously address the posing need of all adolescents, regardless of their race, social status, gender, and other social categorization, we continue to bring our advocacy and health services to each school within the division.

Thus, City Government of Sagay, through the City Population Office, will be conducting U4U Teen trails to 2 High Schools to the following schools in the division:

U4U Teen Trail is one of the Youth Hub Initiative that is highly interactive, entertaining and educational. This whole day event managed and facilitated by our Peer Helpers, aims to deliver critical information to Filipino teens aged 10-19 to prevent teen pregnancy and increase level of awareness among young people.

In connection with this, we kindly request **80 students/participants** from each school, which may be identified by the **Guidance Counselor or School Head**, to participate in the activity.

Further, may we request our Peer Helpers/Educators to be excused from their respective classes to be our Facilitators on this activity. We believe that their involvement in the U4U Teen Trail will not only enhance their learning experience but also will have positive impact on their peers – the Kabataang Sagaynon.
