**SDO SAGAY CITY DELEGATION'S PARTICIPATION IN THE 2025 WESTERN VISAYAS REGIONAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (WVRAA) MEET**

1. The Division of Sagay City's athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, chaperones, technical officials, delegation heads, and division sports officer will participate in the **2025 Western Visayas Regional Athletic Association (WVRAA) Meet** with the theme "**United as Champions in Gearing Up the Journey Toward Excellence.**" The event will be hosted by the Province and Schools Division of Antique from **March 1-8, 2025, at Binirayan Sports Complex, San Jose, Antique.**
2. This activity aims to strengthen sports development in the region and select the best athletes to represent Region VI in the 2025 Palarong Pambansa, which will be held in the Province of Ilocos Norte.
3. The Sagay City delegation, as part of the Negros Occidental Provincial Athletic Association delegation, will be billeted at Moscoso Rios National High School and Moscoso Rios Central School. The regional qualifiers-athletes, coaches, chaperones, trainers, nurse/health officer, and the Division Sports Office, **will depart from Sagay City on February 27, 2025**, while the identified members of the **executive committee will leave on March 1, 2025.**
4. Refer to the annex of this memorandum for the official list of delegates from SDO Sagay City. This memorandum serves as the official Travel Order; however, all teaching and non-teaching personnel must secure authority to travel from their respective school heads.
5. On **February 27, 2025, the Sagay City delegation (athletes, official coaches, local coach, chaperones, trainers, and identified executive committee members)** will assemble at the Sagay City Ceres Bus Terminal at **4:45 AM** and **depart at 5:00 AM** for BREDCO to catch the 8:00 AM special trip of Montenegro Lines. All delegation members must wear the provincial parade uniform and ID, as required by transportation officers for easy identification.
6. Athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, chaperones, officiating officials, and working committee members are advised to have breakfast before departure, as the first meal to be provided by the Province of Negros Occidental delegation will be the morning snack.
7. Likewise, all athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, and chaperones are expected to bring their own bedding, eating utensils, and food containers, especially water tumblers.
8. The official travel of the identified WVRAA Technical Officials will commence on February 28, 2025. However, they may travel ahead of the scheduled date due to the distance of the venue. Their first meal will be dinner on February 28, 2025, and their last meal will be breakfast on March 8, 2025, at Delegate Angel Salazar Jr. Memorial School (DASJMS) and Antique Integrated School (AIS), which will serve as their billeting quarters.
9. Meals and accommodation for the Technical Officials will be covered by WVRAA funds for the specified dates (as per RM 059, s. 2025). While travel and incidental expenses will be chargeable to SEF-Sports funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

10. The **Ocular Inspection and Screening of the Negros Occidental delegation** is scheduled for the **morning of February 28, 2025**, at the billeting school. All athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, and chaperones are required to wear the complete parade uniform provided by the Province of Negros Occidental. They must be present during the inspection conducted by the Regional Screening and Accreditation Committee (RSAC).
11. Enclosed are the Memorandum of SDO Negros Occidental's participation in the WVRAA Memorandum and Regional Memorandum 059, s. 2025 for reference.
12. All Division Sports Officers, officiating and non-officiating officials, coaches, assistant coaches, and chaperones participating in the 2025 WVRAA Meet are required to attend the Sports Forum and Solidarity Meeting on March 1, 2025, at 8:00 AM at the EBJ Gymnasium, Binirayan Sports Complex. All attendees are expected to wear the event T-shirt during the activity.
13. Participation in this activity shall be subject to the **No-Disruption-of-Classes Policy** as stipulated in **DepEd Order No. 09, s. 2005** (*Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Compliance Therewith*). Therefore, school heads are requested to adjust the teaching schedules of the teachers involved in this activity and ensure that an alternate teacher is assigned to handle their classes. This will allow participating teachers to focus on training, preparing the necessary documents for their athletes, and participating in the WVRAA.
14. Furthermore, we encourage school heads to facilitate necessary arrangements for learner-athletes who will miss their classes and quizzes while undergoing training and participating in the WVRAA.
15. Participation and services rendered by nationally paid teaching and teaching-related personnel in the WVRAA sports competition, when held outside regular school days (*as per DO 53, s. 2003*), are eligible for service credits. Non-teaching and contractual personnel, on the other hand, are entitled to **Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC)**. All personnel must submit their **Form 48** on time or according to the designated schedule. Additionally, participants must indicate the time rendered on **Form 48**, specifying their event, school assignment, and position/designation.
16. It is understood that DepEd Sagay City Division commits to integrate the principles of gender equality, equity and sensitivity, non-discrimination, and human rights, in the provision of governance of basic education. This is in line with the DepEd's mandate to ensure access to quality basic education and equal opportunities for all.
17. Expenses for meals, traveling allowance, transportation, accommodation, and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants relative to the conduct of this activity are chargeable against SEF, School MOOE (travel expenses from station to Sagay Terminal only), and any other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
18. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.




