E-SMILE VALIDATION MECHANICS

1. All PSDSs will serve as chief examiners while selected teachers will act as test administrators (See enclosure no. 2). PSDS/chief examiner will receive the testing materials from the division office through the Math EPS and distribute them to the examiners before reporting to their assigned districts/schools.
2. PSDSs and selected teachers from one district may be assigned to administer the test in another district.
3. All learners (100%) per class will take the test, which will assess mastery of:
 - Grade 2 and 3 – Multiplication tables (0-9)
 - Grade 4 to 6 - Four basic mathematical operations
 - Grades 7 to 10 – Mastery of signed number operations, variables, and exponents.
4. Attendance is mandatory. A maximum of three (3) absences per section is allowed for a teacher/school/district to qualify as BEST E-SMILE IMPLEMENTERS.
5. Speed and accuracy will be key factors. Time limit for the test:
 - Learners in SOF/STE classes have 6 minutes to complete the test.
 - Learners in regular classes have 7 minutes to complete the test.
6. Test administrators will check the paper of each learner, record the number of correct responses, and get the average of the whole class and the school's average per year level. Test results will be submitted to the division office through Math EPS not later than 2 days after the conduct of the test using the E-SMILE forms provided.
7. To get the average score per section: total scores of the learners in a class divided by the enrolment (based on form 3), NOT THE NUMBER OF TEST TAKERS. This is to encourage 100% attendance of learners as much as possible.
8. PSDSs will consolidate the results. Identify top 10 sections per grade level in their district for teacher category and top 5 schools for school category.
9. The district/school/teacher with the highest average score across all grade levels will be declared as the BEST E-SMILE PROJECT IMPLEMENTER in both elementary and secondary categories.
