Nomination forms must be submitted on or before **February 21, 2025** to the Council Nomination and Election Committee chaired by **SDS GLADYS AMYLAIN D. SALES, CESO V**, Council Scout Commissioner for proper action thru the Council Office on the given deadline.
5. To defray the cost of Administration such as certificates and awards for the delegates and other documentary paper works such as Council Chairman's Report and Treasurer's Report, proceedings of the Council Meeting and Programs, **registration fee of Php 400.00 (Four Hundred Pesos Only)** will be charged each delegate

chargeable to Local Funds subject to usual according procedures in accordance to Law
