1. The City Veterinary Services Office (CVO) has reported confirmed cases of rabies in dogs in Sagay City, raising serious concerns about public health and safety.
2. In line with our commitment to promote the health and well-being of our learners and the community, all schools are encouraged to support the intensified rabies awareness initiatives.
3. While the school year is officially closed, schools are advised to coordinate with their respective Barangay for any local campaigns or reporting of animal bite cases.



Specifically, we seek your endorsement and assistance in the following:


- ✓ 1. **Distribution of Educational Materials** – Posters, leaflets, and brochures to be displayed and shared in schools and barangays.
