1. Relative to DepEd Memorandum No. 43, s 2025 titled Supplemental Guidelines on the Implementation of the Literacy Remediation Program, the SDO through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), shall conduct the **Division Training for Teachers and School Leaders on the Literacy Remediation Program (LRP)** on **May 8 to 10, 2025** at **Nature's Village Resort, Talisay City**.
2. Attached are the list of participants and the matrices of the activities.
3. The activity falls under the 30-day vacation of teachers; all teachers involved in the activity are entitled to Vacation Service Credits (VSC) equivalent to the actual days of rendered service. The granting of VSC shall be in accordance with DepEd Order No. 13, S 2024 titled Revised Guidelines on the Grant of vacation Service Credits for teachers. And DepEd Order No.9, s 2025 titled "Amendment to DepEd Order No.9, s 2024 (Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar of Activities S.Y. 2024-2025).
4. Food and accommodation of the participants shall be charged against the downloaded National Learning Camp budget allocation from the F.Y. 2025 Current Continuing Funds of the Basic Education Curriculum while travel and other incidental expenses shall be charged against MOOE/local school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination in the provision of such partnership on account of age, school, gender, civil status, disability, religion, or other similar factors, or personal circumstances that run counter to the principles of equal opportunity.
