**RE-ITERATION OF SAGAY CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2023-015 OR KNOWN AS
"SINGLE USE PLASTIC REDUCTION ORDINANCE OF SAGAY"**

1. In relation to the **City Ordinance No. 2023-015** or the ordinance known and cited as **"Single Use Plastic Reduction Ordinance of Sagay City"**, DepEd SDO Sagay City supports this promotion of environmental awareness and action among the public-school campus and institutionalization of public participation of local integrated, comprehensive, and ecological waste management programs.
2. In view thereof, all Public Schools of SDO Sagay City are enjoined to support this ordinance by bringing their own canisters in buying food inside or outside the school campus to reduce single-use plastic wastes.
3. In addition, all Public Schools of SDO Sagay City are enjoined to diligently observe proper waste management by having four (4) trash bins per classroom that shall be labelled as:
 - a. **Biodegradable (madunot)** – food waste, kitchen waste, agri waste or garden waste
 - b. **Recyclable (Pwede pa mapuslan/ magamit liwat)** – plastic, bottles, glass or metal that can be sold to junk shops.
 - c. **Residual (Indi na gid Mapuslan)** – wastes that are collected by garbage trucks and cannot be sold to any junk shops.
 - d. **Infectious or Covid 19-related wastes** – facemasks, tissues
3. All Public Schools' Material Recovery Facility (MRF) shall have four (4) classifications which are:
 - a. **Bottles**
 - b. **Glasses**
 - c. **Iron sheets (yero)**
 - d. **Papers/Cardboards**

4. All Public Schools shall also have one facility for **Plastic Wastes** that will be classified as:
 - a. **Polystrene** - Styrofoam
 - b. **Humok na Plastic** – Packaging Plastics of foods, Plastic cups, balloons
 - c. **Tig-a na Plastic** – Disposable Spoons and Forks, Pail, Pitcher, Plastic Toys
 - d. **P.E.T Polythylene Terephtalate** – Plastic Bottles
5. Additionally, segregated clean and odorless plastic wastes (Polystrene, Humok na Plastic, Tig-a na Plastic, and P.E.T Polythylene Terephtalate) can be sold to **Subay Marketing** located at E.B Magalona, Negros Occidental at P2.00 per kilogram. They can be reached thru these numbers **09668892331 / 09945135125**.
6. Attached to this memorandum are the copies of city ordinance, FAQs and flyers for more information.

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2023-015

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF PLASTIC BAGS AS PACKAGING MATERIALS, THE UTILIZATION OF STYROFOAM AND SINGLE-USE PLASTIC AS FOOD AND BEVERAGE CONTAINER AND USED IN SERVING FOOD AND BEVERAGES IN THE CITY OF SAGAY AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 16 of the Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balance and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;

WHEREAS, Section 3 (I) of R.A. 7160 provides that the Local Government Units shall share with the national government the responsibility in the management and maintenance of ecological balance within their territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (vi) of R.A. 7160 empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to protect the environment and impose appropriate penalties for acts which endanger the environment including such activities which results in the pollution acceleration or eutrophication of rivers and lakes or of ecological imbalance;

WHEREAS, the improper use of plastic materials and disposal of used plastic bags causes adverse impacts and long-term damage to the environment, including contamination of the marine environment, the deaths of thousands of marine animals through ingestion and entanglement, widespread litter and debasement of the urban environment, and increased waste disposal costs;

WHEREAS, the use, and disposal of Polystyrene (a substance more commonly known as Styrofoam) likewise poses harmful effects to environment, and hazardous to humans as study reveals that it contains the toxic substances Styrene and Benzene, suspected carcinogens and neurotoxins;

WHEREAS, the enactment of this ordinance is in line with the stated principles, policies and the provisions of the Constitution and RA 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, to promote and protect the welfare of people and environment.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Sagay in its regular session assembled:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known and cited as **"SINGLE-USE PLASTIC REDUCTION ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAGAY"**.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Ordinance is to minimize if not eliminate the use of single-use plastic carryout bags and polystyrene containers at business establishments and reduce the use of single-use plastic such as plastic cutlery, drinking straws, plastic hand gloves, stirrers and others for serving food and beverages, which may result in litter and significant negative impacts to the environment. This ordinance is also enacted to encourage the utilization of alternative packaging materials such as woven bags (bayong), cloth/paper bags and other similar organic packaging materials in the City of Sagay.

SECTION 3. COVERAGE. This Ordinance covers all business establishments within the jurisdiction of Sagay City, including street vendors who offer goods for sale to the public.

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms are defined:

- a. Alternative packaging materials - refers to recyclable, reusable and/or biodegradable packaging materials that are used in containing carrying, holding and/or transporting goods or products, as an alternative to plastic bag, such as reusable woven bags (bayong), cloth bags, rattan or bamboo baskets, shopping bags made from recycled waste paper and other bags made out of biodegradable materials (e.g. banana leaves, taro leaves, water lily, corn stalk, etc.)
- b. Bring Eco-Friendly Bag (BEB) Program - refers to the program adopted by supermarkets, convenient stores, department stores and other business establishments, whereby customers are enjoined to bring an eco-friendly reusable bags or any other eco-friendly alternative packaging material for purposes of containing, carrying holding and transporting goods or products bought.
- c. Bring Your Own Container (BYOC) Program - refers to the program adopted by convenience stores, coffee shops, restaurants, fast foods, food kiosks, ambulant vendors and other business establishments whereby costumers are encouraged to use their own reusable container when buying food and beverages.
- d. Business Establishment - means any juridical person or entity which furnishes goods to the general public. This shall include but not limited to malls, supermarkets, pharmacies, grocery stores, convenient stores, wet market and public markets, fastfood outlets, coffee shops, cafes, eateries (carinderias) and other food service establishments, market vendors, food kiosks, sari-sari stores, ambulant vendors, general merchandisers like school supplies, hardware stores or any trading business establishments, and the like.
- e. Dry goods - any products that do not require refrigeration or freezing to maintain its freshness or natural state such as textiles, canned goods, leather goods, etc.
- f. No Plastic Day - shall mean use of plastic bags, Styrofoam and single-use plastics in all establishments is prohibited.
- g. Operator shall mean the person in control of, or having the responsibility for, the operation of a Retail or Business Establishment, which may include, but is not limited to, the owner of the Business Establishment.
- h. Plastic bags - shall refer to "sando bags", plastic shopping bags and the like, that is designed to be provided or utilized at the point of sale for containing, carrying, holding and transporting goods, including those claimed to be as non-biodegradable plastic.
- i. Primary Packaging - refers to those types of packaging for containing water, wet produce, snack foods and other similar products.
- j. Recyclable - means material that can be sorted, cleansed, reconstituted and re-used using available recycling collection programs for the purpose of using altered form in the manufacture of a new product.
- k. Sando bags- refer to plastic bags with handles or strings usually made of Low-Density Polyethylene, Polypropylene or other Single Use Plastic material, which is often provided to a customer at the point of sale. This term shall likewise be defined as one similar to the term plastic bag.
- l. Secondary Packaging - refers to packaging that is used to support primary packaging, usually used and intended for the convenience of the consumer;

- m. Single-Use Plastics are items made predominantly of plastic intended for only one-time use, to include drinking cups, plastic ice cream or salad cups, clamshell packaging, plastic cake and pastry box, plastic hand gloves, plastic cutlery such as fork, spoon, or knife, plastic drinking straw, plastic stirrer and the like;
 - n. Street Vendors – refer to persons who travel from place-to-place selling goods to the public, to include ambulant vendors, fish vendors, hawkers, peddlers and the like.
 - o. Styrofoam- is a trademark of a product made up of light, resilient foam of polystyrene. For purposes of this Ordinance the term "Styrofoam" shall refer to the Expanded Polystyrene (EPS) Foam used as containers for food and beverages.
 - p. Wet goods – refers to any product that require refrigeration or freezing to maintain freshness such as fish, meat, fruits and vegetables, and cooked food in restaurants, eateries or carinderias;

SECTION 5. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS.

- a. All business establishments and street vendors shall use and provide any alternative packaging materials as defined under Section 4 of this Ordinance, to a customer for the purpose of carrying away goods or other material from the point of sale.
- b. The general public are enjoined to bring appropriate containers whenever they are going to the market.
- c. All business establishments are encouraged to adopt the "Bring Eco-Friendly Bag" (BEB) Program and "Bring Your Own Container" (BYOC) Program. Nothing in this ordinance prohibits customers from using re-usable bags, eco bags and the like, and re-usable containers which they may bring to the store themselves or from carrying away goods and when buying food and beverages.
- d. Business Establishments are encouraged to give discounts and freebies to users of eco bags and re-usable containers.
- e. Re-usable containers, waxy carton boxes and paper-based containers are required to be used for food that will be taken out from eateries, restaurants, carinderias, fastfood outlets, food service establishments and the like.
- f. A food service business/establishments may provide an alternative drinking straw to a person only upon request.
- g. It is the duty of the operators and/or managers of business establishments to inform their customers about the existence and enforcement of this ordinance within the City of Sagay. They shall likewise brief or train their respective personnel that will be in the frontline to implement this ordinance.
- h. Barangay officials shall take the lead in their respective barangays to ensure that ordinance is strictly implemented.
- i. Posting of Information and Education Campaign (IEC) materials shall be mandatory on all commercial establishments such as sari-sari stores, convenient stores, grocery stores, market stalls, food establishments like eateries, fast-food chains, restaurants, bar and grills, general merchandisers like school supplies, hardware stores or any trading business establishment that will require containers and packaging materials for the product they trade.
- j. The City Information and Tourism Office, in coordination with the Technical Working Group created under this ordinance shall conduct massive information education and



communication campaigns using quad media (print, radio, television/cable and internet) and shall include the promotion of alternative biodegradable packaging materials.

SECTION 6. PROHIBITION. Except otherwise, it shall be unlawful to:

- a. Use and provide plastic bags as primary packaging materials for dry goods except those packed goods by manufacturers.
- b. Use and provide plastic bags as secondary packaging material for wet goods and food items. Plastic used for packing fresh wet goods directly purchased in wet markets are considered secondary packaging.
- c. Use and provide styrofoam and single-use plastics such as plastic drinking cups, plastic ice cream and salad cups, plastic stirrer, plastic cutlery, plastic drinking straw and plastic hand gloves, plastic meal box tray or clamshell packaging, plastic cake and pastry box, and the like, as food and beverages container and food service materials.

SECTION 7. EXCEPTIONS. This ordinance shall not cover the primary packaging of products and such other packaging which forms part of the actual product per se. Such products include, but not limited to, snack foods, frozen foods, hardware items, bottled water or soda, juice drinks, cooking oil, plastic sachet products containing soap, shampoo and conditioner, cosmetics, and the like.

SECTION 8. TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP. For the purpose of this ordinance, a Technical Working Group (TWG) shall be established with the following composition:

SECTION 9. FUNCTION OF THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP. The Technical Working Group (TWG) shall have the following functions:

- a. Formulate Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) for proper enforcement of this Ordinance, if necessary.
- b. Develop a citation ticket to be used by the Law Enforcement Team in the apprehension of violators of this ordinance.
- c. Identify the environmental advocacies, programs and projects to be funded by the City Government including the formulation of a system of rewards and incentives for complying stakeholders.
- d. Oversee the implementation of the provisions of this ordinance including the periodic monitoring thereof.

SECTION 10. LAW ENFORCEMENT TEAM. For purposes of this ordinance, the Law Enforcement Team (LET) shall be composed of the following:

- a. Deputized/authorized ESWM Enforcers
- b. PNP Personnel designated by the Chief of Police
- c. Barangay Officials and Barangay Tanods of the respective (25) barangays of the city; and
- d. Any other duly authorized representative of the Local Chief Executive.

SECTION 11. PENALTY. Any establishment/individuals who violate any of the prohibited acts provided in Section 6 of this ordinance shall be penalized accordingly, to wit:

- a. For Owners, proprietors, managers of the establishments referred to under this ordinance, shall be penalized, as follows:

First Offense	-	A fine of Two Thousand (P2,000.00) Pesos
Second Offense	-	A fine of Three Thousand (P3,000.00) Pesos and temporary closure of the establishment for ten (10) calendar days
Third Offense	-	A fine of Five Thousand (P5,000.00) Pesos and revocation of the business license.

- b. For Street vendors who violate the provisions as cited under Section 6 shall be penalized as follows:

First Offense	-	A fine of Five Hundred (P500.00) Pesos
Second Offense	-	A fine of One Thousand (P 1,000.00) Pesos
Third Offense	-	A fine of Three Thousand (P3,000.00) Pesos and cancellation of business license or permit as the case may be.

SECTION 12. INCENTIVES TO ENFORCEMENT UNITS. All apprehending personnel deputized to implement this ordinance shall be given incentive corresponding to thirty (30%) of the total fines and penalties imposed upon and collected from the violators he actually apprehended.

SECTION 13. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR). The Technical Working Group shall formulate the necessary Implementing Rules and Regulations of this ordinance within thirty (30) days from the approval of this ordinance, and the same shall be transmitted to the City Mayor for approval.

SECTION 13. PHASE OUT SCHEDULE. The use of plastic bags and Styrofoam in the City of Sagay shall be regulated and phased-out in the following manner:

- a. **First Year (January 01, 2024 – December 31, 2024)** - No Plastic Day every Tuesday and Friday
- b. **Second Year (January 01, 2025-December 31, 2025)** – No Plastic Day every Tuesday, Friday and Sunday
- c. **Third Year (January 01, 2026 onwards)** - Total ban of the use of plastic bags, styrofoam and single-use plastics as defined under this ordinance, in all establishments in the City of Sagay.

SECTION 14. FUNDING. The City Government shall allocate funds for effective implementation of this ordinance which shall cover all expenses to be incurred in the information dissemination.

SECTION 15. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any part of this Ordinance is declared not valid, unconstitutional or unlawful, such declaration shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections or parts thereof, which shall remain or continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 16. REPEALING CLAUSE. All previous ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 17. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect on January 2024 and compliance with the requirements under Section 59 of R.A. 7160, as to posting and publication.
