**ADDITIONAL ALLOCATION FOR SCHOOL MOOE FOR FY 2025
FROM FY 2024 GAA CONTINUING APPROPRIATION**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

Public Secondary and Elementary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. In reference to FSBD-2025-015 and MOUF-2025-0271 pertaining to the provision of additional allocation for Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) to public Elementary, Junior and Senior High Schools, and the CY 2024 Financial Accountability Report (FAR 1) of this Division detailing the Unobligated Allotments from FY 2024 GAA under Support to Schools and Learners Program that is valid for release, obligation, and disbursement until December 31, 2025, this to inform the schools listed in **Annex A** of their additional MOOE allocation for utilization this CY 2025.
2. The additional allocation for school MOOE issued with SubARO were intended to adjust the MOOE allocation provided under the FY 2025 GAA, which includes the MOOE allocation for newly established schools and newly converted integrated schools, based on the latest data reported on the LIS for SY 2024-2025 as of January 30, 2025
3. The use of this additional MOOE allocation shall be subject to the provisions stated on DepEd Order No. 8, s.2019 entitled Revised Implementing Guidelines on the Direct Release, Use, Monitoring and Reporting of MOOE and Other Funds Managed by Schools.
4. In the release of this additional MOOE allocation, the schools shall be required to update the school PPMP, APP and AIP/WFP for the new or additional PPAs to be funded in the use of this additional funds. Duly approved supplemental APP and AIP/WFP shall therefore support the Request for Cash Advance of schools to download this additional MOOE.


