**PARTICIPATION TO THE NEGROS MONTHLY ATHLETICS COMPETITION
(FOR THE MONTHS OF JUNE-DECEMBER 2025)**

1. The Province of Negros Occidental, through its Special Programs and Concerns Division, cordially invites our Athletics Team to participate in the Negros Monthly Athletics Competition, scheduled on the following dates: June 28, July 19, August 16, September 13, October 4, November 15, and December 6, 2025. The events will be held at the Panaad Park and Stadium in Bacolod City and the Bago City Track and Field.
2. This office has identified and selected schools with qualified athletics teams to participate in the aforementioned activity. Attached to this memorandum is the list of selected student-athletes, coaches, and trainers. Coaches are required to secure a duly signed waiver or parent/guardian permit before allowing student-athletes to join the competition. Additionally, coaches must obtain official approval through a Travel Order issued by their respective school heads.
3. This activity aims to further develop the skills, discipline, and competitive experience of our student-athletes in the field of athletics. It serves as a vital part of their training and preparation as they represent Sagay City in higher-level competitions, including provincial, regional, and ultimately, the Palarong Pambansa. By exposing them to regular competitive events, we help ensure their readiness to perform at their best on larger stages.
4. Teachers who participate and render services beyond regular working hours shall be entitled to Service Credits, in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2023. Teaching-related and non-teaching personnel may be granted Compensatory Time Off (CTO) for services rendered during weekends and holidays, as provided under Civil Service Commission (CSC) and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004, on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered. The processing of Service Credits and/or Compensatory Overtime Credits shall be facilitated by the schools through their respective Administrative Officers, upon complete submission of all required documents by the personnel involved in the said activity.
5. Meals, travel, and other incidental expenses of the participants relative to the conduct of this activity are chargeable to School MOOE/PTA/Canteen/ and other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination on account of age, school, gender, civil status, disability, religion, or other similar factors, or personal circumstances that run counter to the principles of equal opportunity.
7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
