**IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED DEWORMING ACTIVITY**

To: Asst. Schools Division Superintendent  
Chief Education Supervisors – CID and SGOD  
Public Schools District Supervisors  
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads  
All Others Concerned

1. To improve the health of school-aged children, the Department of Health (DOH) and the Department of Education (DepEd) launched the Integrated Helminth Control Program (IHCP) to reduce cases of Soil-Transmitted Helminthiasis (STH), or intestinal worms, which can hinder growth and learning. Children aged 5 to 12 are most at risk.
2. As part of School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) pre-implementation, deworming is essential to maximize program benefits. If not done beforehand, it may still be administered within the first three months
3. In line with this, the SHNU of DepEd SDO-Sagay, in partnership with the Sagay City Health Office, will conduct a **School-Based Deworming Activity on August 28, 2025 (Thursday)**. Due to limited deworming medicine supply, distribution will follow the prioritization scheme below:

**Priority for Deworming Medicine Distribution:**

- I. First Priority – All School-Based Feeding Program Beneficiaries
- II. Second Priority – All learners from Kindergarten to Grade 6

**Medicine Distribution and Claiming:**

- I. Refer to Annex A for the allocation of deworming medicines per school.
  - II. WinS Coordinators are tasked to facilitate and distribute the deworming tablets to class advisers.
  - III. Medicines can be claimed at the SHNU, Division Office from August 18 to 26, 2025.
  - IV. Kindly look for the Nurse-in-Charge when claiming.
4. To ensure the safe and successful conduct of the activity, please observe the following:
- I. Class advisers must distribute and collect signed Parent Consent Forms.
  - II. Only learners with signed consent will be dewormed.**
  - III. School Nurse or trained personnel must conduct a health orientation prior to deworming.
  - IV. School Heads must coordinate with nearby Barangay Health Stations, BHW's should be on standby.
  - V. Adverse effect treatments will be covered by the School Clinic Fund.
  - VI. Follow proper first-aid and referral protocols per School Health Section guidelines.

Common Adverse Reaction	Management
Hypersensitivity/ Allergy	<b>3-12 years old:</b> Loratadine 5mg/5ml – 1tsp once daily <b>6-12 years old:</b> Loratadine 10mg tablet – ½ to 1 tablet once daily <b>6 years old and above:</b> Cetirizine 10mg tablet – 1 tablet once daily
Mild Abdominal Pain	<b>6 years old and above:</b> Hyoscine N-Butylbromide 10mg tablet 1 tablet, 3 times daily as needed
Diarrhea	<b>9-12 years old:</b> Loperamide 2mg tablet – 1 tablet, 4 times daily
Erratic Worm Migration through Mouth or Nose	Gently pull out the worm Reassure the child and parent Repeat deworming with another dose after 24 hours

**Note:** Medications must be given by trained school health personnel with parental consent. Monitor learners and refer to a health facility if needed.

- Schools are required to prepare an accomplishment report after the deworming activity, including the inventory of deworming tablets. The WinS Coordinator shall consolidate and submit the reports to SGOD-SHNU. Please accomplish the form using this link: <https://acesse.one/I3Muv>
- Deadline for submission of the Deworming Accomplishment Report, including documentation and a short narrative with pictures, is on or before September 9, 2025 (Monday) at the Division-SHNU.
- The **Data Privacy Act and related policies of the DOH and DepEd** shall be followed in the handling and sharing of data.
- It is understood that DepEd Sagay City Division commits to integrate the principles of gender equality, equity and sensitivity, non-discrimination, and human rights, in the provision of governance of basic education. This is in line with the DepEd's mandate to ensure access to quality basic education and equal opportunities for all.
