1. Anent to DepEd Memorandum No. 223, s. 2016 titled, Strengthening the implementation of the Gulayan sa Paaralan Program (GPP) in Public Elementary and Secondary Schools Nationwide, a year-end program monitoring review and evaluation shall be conducted as part of the program evaluation activities.

6. Travelling expenses incurred by the participants related to this activity are chargeable against School MOOE/ Local Funds, while snacks will be charged to the SBFP Program Support Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
