- The School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) SY 2024-2025 implementation has ended last March 21, 2025 both the Nutritious Food Products and Hot Meals.  - BLT CK Modality: Eusebio Lopez Memorial Integrated Schools
 - NFP modality- Pacol Elementary School

- Travel, incidental, and lunch meal expenses incurred by the participants related to this activity shall be charged against the School MOOE/Local Funds, while snacks will be charged to the SBFP Program Support Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
