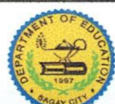
3. Anent to this, the following identified personnel are the participants to this training:

Meanwhile, the participant from the SDO-SGOD Office shall process the travel order in accordance with the established procedures and guidelines of the Division Office. 5. Travel, meals, and incidental expenses of participants from the schools shall be charged to the School MOOE or other available local funds, while expenses of personnel from the Division Office shall be charged to the Division MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

6. Teachers involved in the activity shall be entitled to service credits for services rendered beyond office hours, on weekends, and during holidays, not to exceed fifteen (15) days, in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, titled "Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers." Meanwhile, non-teaching personnel shall be granted Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) for services rendered beyond regular working hours, on weekends, and during holidays, pursuant to Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004, on "Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered."

3. Be informed that **no free meals will be provided during the workshop, and no training fee will be collected from the participants.**

4. All other related expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and regulations.
