7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

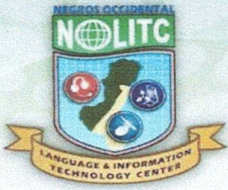



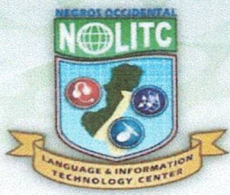
