Environmental Greetings!

Please be advised that the criteria and guidelines for the two environmental contests namely: WAIS – “Waste-to-Assets Innovation sa Sagay” (Technology-Based Solutions) and TrashFormers (Upcycling & Art Contest) have been formally revised to ensure transparency, fairness, and clarity for all participants.

1. WAIS – “Waste-to-Assets Innovation sa Sagay” (Technology-Based Solutions)
 - Composting systems, plastic shredders, eco-bricks applications, apps for waste tracking, etc.
2. TrashFormers (Upcycling & Art Contest)
 - Functional upcycled items (furniture, home décor, accessories, toys, educational materials).
 - Basura art (sculptures, installations, paintings, mixed media using at least 80% waste) .

These contests are open to public Junior and Senior High Schools within Sagay City. Below are the detailed guidelines for participation:

I. Eligibility

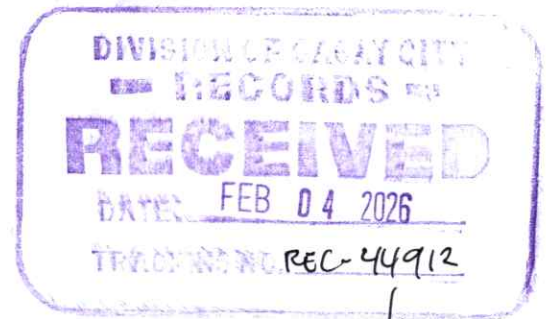
- Open to all Junior and Senior High Schools within the city.
- Entries may be individual or group-based, with a maximum of 10 members per group and one (1) coach/adviser.

II. Entry Requirements

- Materials: At least 70–80% of materials used must come from waste (recyclables, discarded items, scrap, etc.).
- Technology Entries: Must be functional, tested, and properly documented (concept, design, process, and application).
- Upcycling / Art Entries: Must be creative, original, safe for public display or use, and must not duplicate existing innovations already implemented by the City.
- Art on Canvas: Must follow the required size of 2 ft x 2 ft.

III. Use

- The City may borrow, display, showcase, or temporarily safekeep these works to support Solid Waste Management (SWM) programs and advocacy.



IV. Criteria for Judging

A. Technology Entries

1. **Functionality & Workability – 30%**
 - Practicality, ease of use, and successful testing of the prototype/product.
2. **Innovation & Originality – 25%**
 - New, unique, or significantly improved ideas compared to existing solutions.
3. **Documentation & Process – 20%**
 - Completeness of concept notes, design, testing procedures, and application details.
4. **Environmental Impact – 15%**
 - Relevance to Solid Waste Management and sustainability contribution.
5. **Presentation & Demonstration – 10%**
 - Clarity, confidence, and effectiveness in presenting the entry.

Total: 100%

B. Upcycling / Art Entries

1. **Creativity & Originality – 30%**
 - Artistic value, uniqueness, and innovative use of waste materials.
2. **Relevance to Theme (SWM Advocacy) – 25%**
 - Clear reflection of environmental awareness and waste management concepts.
3. **Use of Waste Materials – 20%**
 - Compliance with 70–80% waste-based material requirement.
4. **Aesthetic & Safety – 15%**
 - Visual appeal, craftsmanship, and safety for public display/use.
5. **Presentation – 10%**
 - Organization, clarity, and impact during explanation/display.

Total: 100%

V. Registration

- Participating schools shall register their entries by sending an email to scenrosagay@gmail.com, indicating the contest category, list of participating students, and their coach/adviser.

- Display and Evaluation of Entries: March 17, 2026
- Announcement of Winners: March 18, 2026

VII. Cash Prizes

- 2nd Place – ₱15,000
- 3rd Place – ₱10,000
- 2 Consolation Prizes – ₱5,000 each


TrashFormers – Upcycling & Art Contest
